Summary of the department, manpower and services.

The Farmingdale Fire department provides fire and rescue services out of 2 stations: 289 Maine Ave and 427 Litchfield Rd. From those stations, we respond with 2 pumpers and a heavy rescue. Call volume is about 110-120 calls annually and on occasion helping Gardiner Ambulance. Generally, there are no medical responders unless requested.

Currently we have a roster of 20 (19 regulars and 2 juniors) and applications for 2 more this past week.
